Scope and Contents

The Charles Bowden collection contains materials related to Tennessee Williams and his plays. Bowden was the producer for the Broadway production of *The Night of the Iguana* and he and his wife, the actress Paula Laurence, were personal friends of Williams. The collection is divided into two series: Series I. Tennessee Williams Plays, ca. 1964-1976; and Series II. Williams-Related Materials.

Series I. contains scripts and some production materials for plays including *The Night of the Iguana*, an unproduced musical version of *Camino Real*, and *Slapstick Tragedy*. Some of these scripts include multiple handwritten and typescript revisions by Williams.

Materials in Series II. include correspondence, clippings, photographs, and programs relating to Williams.
