### **Biographical Sketch**

James W. Moll began teaching in the University of Texas at Austin Department of Theatre and Dance in 1941 and was made a professor emeritus in 1979. In his thirty-seven years at the University he directed more than one hundred productions of plays, musical comedies and operas from a broad range of American and European dramatic literature. He held degrees from the University of Michigan.

#### **Scope and Contents**

The James W. Moll Papers, 1949-1978, contain typed and photocopied scenes from plays, as well as a complete script for *Show Boat* and printed music for *Henry IV*, *Part II*. The remaining teaching files include handouts of exercises and information for drama students, as well as illustrative prints and other classroom materials.
