## **Scope and Contents**

The Ernest Hemingway Literary File consists of over 1500 images, chiefly of Ernest's childhood and family members (siblings, parents, grandparents, and siblings' spouses and children), and of his parents' travels in the United States and Cuba. Formats include cartes-de-visite, cabinet cards, matted and unmatted formal portraits, snapshots, daguerreotypes, ambrotypes, tintypes, glass negatives and positive transparencies, and a nitrate negative. Most of the snapshots were made by Ernest's father, Dr. Clarence Edmonds Hemingway.

This collection forms a part of the Literary File Photography Collection, which is comprised of photographs and albums withdrawn from the libraries and/or papers of literary figures. generally include portraits and images collected by or of those figures.
